Now open are a Chipotle outlet and BGR The Burger Joint. It is Chipotle's second airport location in the country and this outlet is 801 square feet. Located in Concourse A/B, Chipotle features a menu of burritos, burrito bowls, tacos and salads. The restaurant also also has vegetable, turkey and ahi tuna burgers with side dishes that include sweet potato fries and asparagus spears.
