

New Copa cabin on four flights



The Economy Extra cabin on Copa has 24 seats

Starting on June 1, [Copa Airlines](#) added two new elements to its service from [The Hub of the Americas](#)® in Panama to four major destinations in its network.

Copa Airlines aircraft traveling between Panama and Montevideo in Uruguay, Buenos Aires, Sao Paulo and Los Angeles will have the Dreams Business Class cabin with 16 lie-flat seats, 16-inch remote-controlled touchscreens, an extensive entertainment program, power outlets and USB connections, as well as space to store personal items.
