Vistara now offers 20 minutes of complimentary Wi-Fi to all passengers on international flights

[Vistara](#), a joint venture of the [Tata Group](#) and [Singapore Airlines](#), is now offering 20 minutes of complimentary Wi-Fi connectivity onboard international flights, operated using its 787-9 Dreamliner and A321neo aircraft, across all three cabin classes. This initiative makes Vistara the first Indian airline to do so, the press release said.

The complimentary 20-minute Wi-Fi access enables passengers to stay connected and allows passengers to purchase extended Wi-Fi plans using Indian credit/debit cards as desired. This service allows passengers to receive one-time passwords via email, facilitating the purchase of extended in-flight Wi-Fi services during the active session.
