

Airbus Services to retrofit Delta's incoming A350s



The retrofit program will reflect a total nose-to-tail cabin modification

In one of the world's largest and most comprehensive cabin upgrade programs ever launched in an airline's A350 program, [Airbus Services](#) is to retrofit and upgrade nine A350 aircraft entering [Delta's](#) fleet that previously flew at another airline.

Airbus will provide all the Services Bulletins (including engineering drawings) and kits required for the complete cabin and technical support throughout the duration of the upgrade solution.
