During the pandemic, Etihad Engineering utilized the latest thermal scanning solutions at the facility's entry points, exercised remote working arrangements, and organized consistent disinfection of aircraft, hangars, and offices to ensure the safety and well-being of staff and customers onsite. The company invested in a state-of-the-art medical mask production facility onsite which has delivered more than 1.8 million masks to the aviation industry, and manufactured 3D printed face shields for the UAE's frontline health workers.

To support a safe return to the skies for airlines around the world, Etihad Engineering launched a range of service solutions. It leveraged its comprehensive Part21J and Part21G capabilities to design, manufacture, certify and install aircraft cabin parts.

Etihad Engineering's facility is located in Abu Dhabi, adjacent to Abu Dhabi International Airport, over an area of 500,000 square meters. Aircraft hangars at the facility cover approximately 66,000 square meters, including 10,000 square meters of aircraft painting facilities, and a custom-designed hangar that can accommodate up to three A380s simultaneously. The company has successfully completed maintenance projects over the years for airlines from all over the world.
