
FL Technics expands line maintenance services

Integrated aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul service provider [FL Technics](#), part of [Avia Solutions Group](#), has extended its EASA Part-145 approval to include the A320neo aircraft family for line maintenance services.

The company has already added the A320neo aircraft family to its main line station in Vilnius, Lithuania. Further expansion is being planned for Dubai, Vienna, Tbilisi, Riga and Kiev airports – where FL Technics currently operates EASA Part-145 approved line stations with A320s, A330s and 737 capabilities.
