
Singapore Airlines selects GuideU for 787 fleet

Singapore Airlines has chosen [Lufthansa Technik](#)'s GuideU 1000-Series emergency floor path marking system for installation on its new 787-10 fleet. A total of 49 aircraft will be delivered to Singapore's flag carrier starting in the first quarter of 2018. Singapore Airlines already relies on GuideU for its A350 fleet.
