Delivery of the seats is expected to begin in the first quarter of 2025, with the inaugural order completed by the end of 2029. There is potential for fifty additional aircraft to follow, the press release said.

The Series 9 in vegan leather will be pre-reclined to 21.5 degrees for optimal passenger comfort and will feature custom trim and finish. The seta colour is a dark navy with touches of vivid red and bold yellow, colours associated with Pegasus Airlines' livery.
