

# Emirates introduces Premium Economy product on flights to Osaka

[Emirates](#) hosted an exclusive tour of its upgraded four-class A380 aircraft at Osaka Kansai International Airport ([KIX](#)), this week, showcasing its Premium Economy product that was launched on the Osaka-Dubai route on June 11. The product launch in Osaka follows the introduction of the Premium Economy cabin on flights to Tokyo Narita ([NRT](#)) in December 2023.

The Emirates' Premium Economy launch event was attended by Marwan Alnaqbi, Deputy Head of Mission, UAE Embassy and Hayato Shingu, Executive Officer Deputy Chief Commercial Office, Kansai Airport Authority as well as Emirates' trade partners and the local media.

Within the four-class configuration of an Emirates A380, the Premium Economy cabin is situated at the forefront of the main deck, with 56 seats arranged in a 2-4-2 configuration. Passengers in Premium Economy receive curated inflight amenities, a wide array of beverage options and more.

Emirates’ Premium Economy is now flying to more than fifteen destinations globally, including New York JFK, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Houston, London Heathrow, Sydney, Auckland, Christchurch, Melbourne, Singapore, Mumbai, Bangalore, Sao Paulo, Tokyo Narita and Dubai.
