A mix of tables, sofas, group and individual seating gives plenty of choice to dine, work, or relax comfortably, and a dedicated children's play area provides families with an area of their own while in the lounge. Soundproof booths ensure that phone calls can be carried out in privacy.

The design of the new offering draws from the culture and heritage of the surrounding Campinas region. Production expansion of two significant agricultural crops – sugar cane and coffee – impelled the rapid industrialization of the area.

"The importance of these two crops is demonstrated by their representation on the city's coat of arms. It is the deep, earthy tones of this emblem that form the pallet of the Ambaar Club's design," reads the December press release from Airport Dimensions. "The iron that was a crucial element in the industrialization of Campinas also features strongly in the scheme, while cement accents evoke the spirit of urbanization, and wood highlights add warmth. The whole scheme is softened by fresh greenery."
