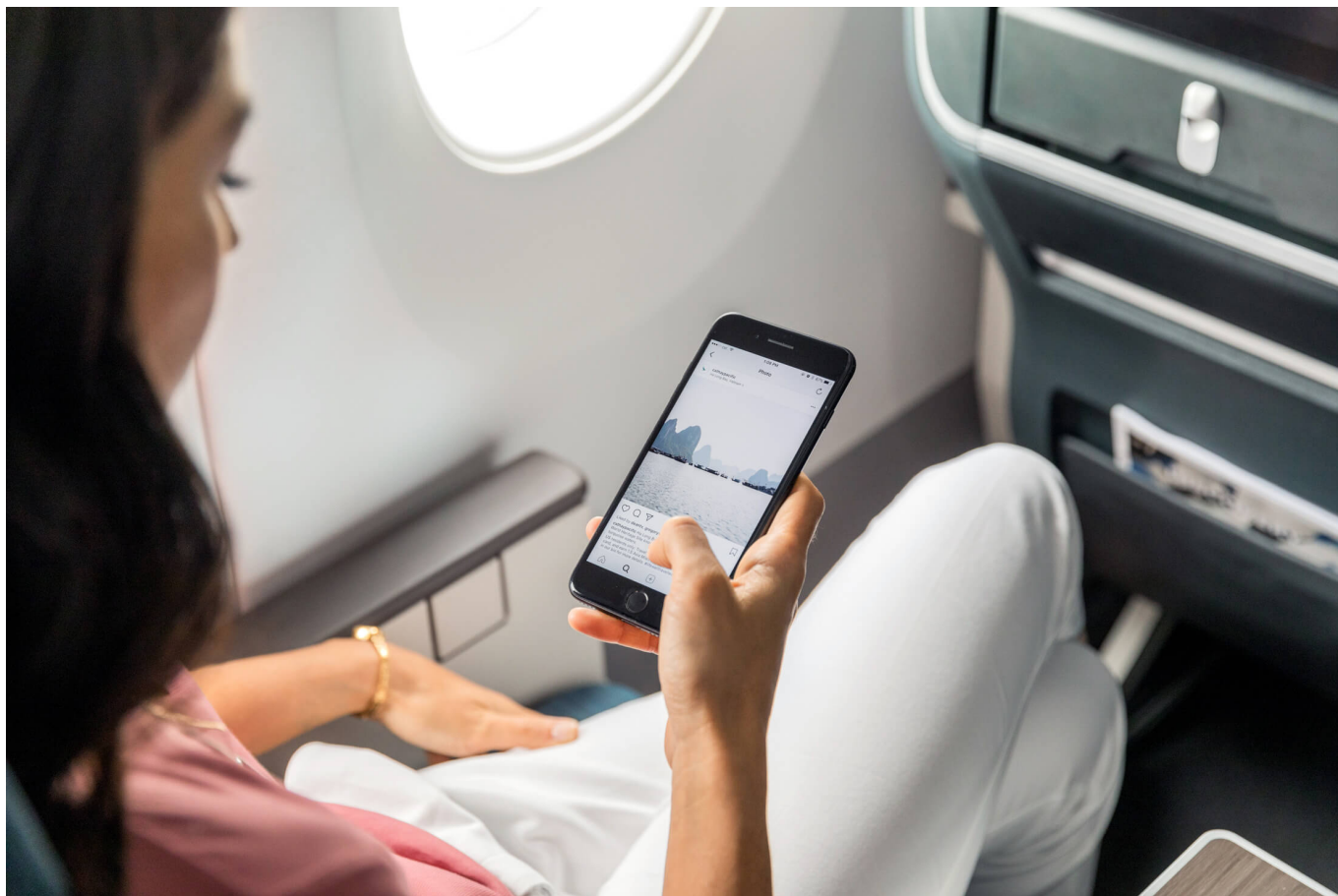


Cathay Pacific extends complimentary inflight Wi-Fi to Cathay Gold members
