Partner for the comprehensive upgrade is Starlink. The system is based on satellite technology and enables internet access in the air just like on the ground.

Higher bandwidth and speed will enable streaming, cloud-based working, and other high-speed applications during flights in the future. The new internet service will be free of charge for all status passengers and Travel ID users, across all travel classes.

The cooperation is part of the Lufthansa Group's extensive investments in new aircraft and premium product and service innovations along the entire travel chain.

"In our anniversary year, in which we are celebrating Lufthansa's 100th birthday, we have decided to introduce a new high-speed internet solution from Starlink for all our airlines. The gradual introduction of Starlink on board of Lufthansa Group aircraft will begin as early as the second half of this year. By 2029, the entire fleet will be equipped with the new connectivity offering. Further details will be announced in the course of the year.
