Turkish Technic provided base maintenance services to 649 aircraft

Expanding its capacity and capabilities to meet the needs of the aviation sector, the aviation services provider added new achievements to its service portfolio in 2022. The company has completed base maintenance operations for 787 Dreamliner and A350 aircraft for the first time during the year and carried out its first 777-300ER landing gear overhaul. Adding 1.193 aircraft part numbers to its capability in 2022, the MRO company expanded its maintenance-repair capabilities and the range of services it offers its customers.

The company provided base maintenance services to 649 aircraft, completed overhaul operations of 221 landing gears and serviced over 119,000 components throughout 2022.
