The flight was operated by Captain Randy Howe, Canada Jetlines' Chief Pilot, and Captain Colin Forrest. Both pilots recently completed the Canada Jetlines' A320 pilot training and simulator check ride monitored by Transport Canada.

Jetlines will operate a fleet of A320s targeting a start in 2022, subject to Transport Canada approval. The Canadian carrier was created to provide passengers more choice when travel to destinations within the U.S., Caribbean, and Mexico.
